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IMPORTANT PHONE SETTINGS


The following phone settings are necessary to enable use of the phone with the AdvanceCommunicator:

- 1. Press > Settings > DC Settings > Direct Connect ON
- 2. Press > Settings > DC Settings > Headset Mode > Headset button starts DC calls. [DC button].
- 3. Press > Settings > Others > Accessibility > TTY > TTY Off.
- 4. Increase or Decrease the volume must be done while phone is connected to the unit and is on an active call.

■ SETTING UP THE ADVANCECOMMUNICATOR™

- 1. Place the AdvanceCommunicator™ in a convenient position within easy reach of an AC power outlet.
- 2. Attach the plug at the end of the coil cord of the handset into the corresponding RJ45 handset receptacle on the back of the AdvanceCommunicator™.
- 3. Plug the power supply into the wall AC power outlet and the round barrel plug at the end of the cord of the power supply into the corresponding power receptacle on the back of the AdvanceCommunicator™
- 4. At this point the LED will flash RED



INSTALLING THE PORTABLE INTO THE **ADVANCECOMMUNICATOR™**


- 1. Lift the Mobile phone release mechanism. (See Diagram 4)
- 2. Slide the mobile phone into the pocket from left to right. Lower release mechanism until locked in place.
- 3. Turn the mobile phone on.
- 4. To remove the mobile phone from the Cradle, lift release mechanism and slide mobile phone out the pocket.

MAKING AND RECEIVING CALLS IN HANDS FREE MODE.

- 1. To make a call in Hands-free mode, dial the desired number on the phone keypad and press SEND/GREEN BUTTON. Speak towards the Microphone which is situated on the bottom right corner of the AdvanceCommunicator™ USB Connector Audio Connector 2 Pin into AdvanceCommunicator™.
- 2. The voice of the person you are calling will be heard via the built-in speaker in the AdvanceCommunicator™

- 3. To receive a call in Hands-free mode, press SEND/GREEN BUTTON on the phone or press shortly on the PTT/Space bar and speak towards the Microphone. The caller's voice will be heard via the built-in speaker in the AdvanceCommunicator™
- 4. To end a call in hands-free mode press the END/RED button on the phone.





MAKING AND RECEIVING CALLS VIA THE HANDSET.

- To make a call using the AdvanceCommunicator™ Handset, dial the desired number on the phone's keypad and press SEND/GREEN button. Use the handset as you would with a regular desktop phone.
- 2. To receive a call with the Handset, lift the Handset and press the SEND/GREEN button on the phone's keypad. Use the handset as you would with a regular desktop phone.
- 3. To end a call while using the handset, place the handset back into the cradle and press the END/RED button on the phone.



■ USE OF THE ADVANCECOMMUNICATOR™ WITH DISPATCH CALLS

- 1. To answer a dispatch call in Hands-free mode, press and hold down the PTT/Space Bar and speak towards the Microphone.
- 2. To answer a dispatch call using the handset, pick up the handset, press and hold down the round PTT button on the back of the Handset and speak into the handset as you would with a regular desktop phone.
- 3. To hear the other party in a dispatch call, release the PTT/Space bar (in Hands-free mode) or the round PTT handset button if using the Handset

VOLUME CONTROL

The volume of the AdvanceCommunicator™ can be increased or lowered with the volume buttons on the side of the phone.

RECORDING FEATURE

- 1. The AdvanceCommunicator™ will allow the recording of audio traffic with an external recording device via a 3.5mm plug on the back of the AdvanceCommunicator™
- 2. Dispatch calls will be recorded both audio in and audio out.
- 3. Cellular calls will be recorded audio-in.



SUMMARY OF LED INDICATORS

Flashing RED: Phone not connected to the Base

Steady RED: Phone is connected to the Base with

power OFF

Steady GREEN: Phone connected with power ON

CHARGING THE BATTERY

With the portable turned off, the $AdvanceCommunicator^\intercal$ will charge the battery of the handset.

PART # AT8428A - PALM MIC

- 1. To use a Palm Mic. with the AdvanceCommunicator™ unplug the privacy handset supplied with the unit (and remove it from its cradle) and plug the RJ45 connector of the Palm Mic into the corresponding RJ45 receptacle on back of the AdvanceCommunicator™
- **2.** Once connected, the pressing of the switch on the Palm Mic. will activate the Palm Mic.



PART # AT8421A - HEADSET

- 1. To use the Headset with the AdvanceCommunicator™ unplug the privacy handset supplied with the unit (and remove it from its cradle) and plug the RJ45 connector of t ea t into the corresponding RJ45 receptacle on back of the AdvanceCommunicator™
- **2.** Once connected, audio will be transferred to the Headset





3. PTT calls can be made with the PTT/Space Bar or the PTT button on the cable on the Headset.

PART # AT8400A - FOOT PEDAL

- 1. To use the Foot Pedal with the AdvanceCommunicator™ unplug the privacy handset supplied with the unit (and remove it from its cradle)
- 2. Plug the RJ45 connector of the Y Adapter Cable (Part # AT8405A supplied) into the corresponding RJ45 receptacle on back of the AdvanceCommunicator™
- **3.** Plug the RJ45 connector of the Foot pedal into one of the corresponding RJ45 receptacle of the Y Adapter

4. To use both the Headset and Foot Pedal with the AdvanceCommunicator™ simultaneously, use the Y connector adapter **Part # 8405A** supplied with the Foot Pedal..





- 5. Unplug the privacy handset supplied with the unit (and remove it from its cradle) and plug the RJ45 connector of the Y Adapter Cable into the corresponding RJ45 receptacle on back of the AdvanceCommunicator™
- 6. Plug the Headset and Foot Pedal into the corresponding RJ45 receptacles of the Y Adapter Connector.



NOTE: If neither the headset nor Foot Pedal work, swap around the plugs into the Y Adapter Connector.

7. Once connected, the Headset and Foot Pedal will function as set out ahove
